# TOWN OF WINFALL TOWN COUNCIL MEETING December 9, 2019 7:00 PM WINFALL TOWN HALL, WINFALL, NC 27985

The regular monthly meeting of the Winfall Town Council was called to order by Mayor Fred Yates at 7:00 p.m... Invocation was given by Councilman Steav Congdon and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Yates.

### **Committee Reports:**

Beautification: Debbie Whedbee announced that the Christmas Parade was a great success, with 42 entries. It included 4 bands, 3 high schools and 1 university. She commended the announcers on the outstanding job entertaining and announcing each participant and how they really stepped up to the plate; PCHS Assistant Principal Mrs. Teressa Blanchard, and PCMS Assistant Principal Mr. Lister, Ms. Whedbee explained that the announcers had been volunteering the past 3 years and suggested a \$50.00 gift card to each in support of the Christmas Parade. She announced that the next event would be the Christmas decoration contest, in honor of the late Mrs. Leslie White. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners will be selected on December 31 2019. The winners will be awarded a monetary gift card in the amount of (1<sup>st</sup> \$100.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$75.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$50.00) which will be announced at the January Town Meeting. Ms. Whedbee discussed the goals for 2020 Christmas Parade which includes: (a.) needing more bodies to assist with the lineup of the Parade. (b.) Because ECSU students will miss their lunch time on campus, we need to prepare lunch for them. (c.) The town need to order new magnate signs for Town Council, Grand Marshal and a New Christmas Parade Banner!

Mayor Yates and Councilmembers all commented on how outstanding the Christmas Parade was. Councilman Rominger said the participants were great and it was the largest crowd seen on Winfall grounds.
